Holy Cross, Sacred Heart, St. Rita, and St. Therese

Today's feast originated in Canada in the 17th century with devotion to the Holy Family. In 1921, Pope Benedict XV added it to the Church's universal calendar. The feast encourages modeling family life on the Holy Family during periods of social change and the breakdown of family life.

Our 1st reading from Sirach offers guidance on parent-child relationships that foster a "house raised in justice." The Responsorial Psalm and the 2nd reading that follow encourage family members to walk in God's ways and "see the prosperity of Jerusalem all the days of your life."

The Gospel reading concerns protecting the Child Jesus at all costs so that his life's mission could be accomplished. The Flight into Egypt exemplifies a "family strategy" for identifying areas of danger and developing effective child-protection plans.

Consider what significantly impacts family life today, such as the economy, digital addiction, gun violence, education, nutrition, and family cohesion. Child-raising demands on parents are enormous. What is the real harm, and when and how to shield children from it? On the other hand, when and how should parents allow their children the struggles that build resilience and strength for the future?

The Holy Family had God's grace for its family life. Today's parents can look to the Sacrament of Marriage to ensure the grace of a good family life.


