## The Wounded Healer

Whenever we look at a crucifix we see the wounds in the hands and side of Christ. We also see His wounds in pictures of His post-resurrection appearances. That's right: after rising from the dead He still has his wounds. On the Sunday after His resurrection He invites the doubting Thomas to touch his wounds. And today our Risen Savior asks us to see his presence in all the wounded people that we see. Some people are being wounded by hunger. Others by drug abuse. Some are wounded by domestic violence. Others by medical problems. Some are wounded by gossip. Others by prejudice. Some are wounded by slander and others are homeless.

In today's Gospel we see two persons who are hurting: the dying daughter of the synagogue official and the woman suffering with hemorrhages for 12 years. They remind us that no one escapes the experience of being wounded. Jesus brought healing to both of them. He did not hide his wounds and we should not hide our wounds. Rather, we should ask, "How can I be a wounded healer? How can I use my woundedness to help others?"
