Pastors and Parochial Vicars

Within a diocese some priests serve as pastors and others serve as parochial vicars (often called associate pastors). On June 26th Fr. Marv Enneking will become the pastor of the WOHVn in Faith Area Catholic Community and I will become the parochial vicar. So what are the roles of pastors and parochial vicars in the Area Catholic Communities of our diocese?

A pastor is a priest who, under the authority of the diocesan bishop, exercises the pastoral care of a parish or parishes by carrying out the functions of teaching, sanctifying and governing. He is joined in this endeavor by a parochial vicar or deacon or both.

A pastor is bound to preach the Word of God to those living in his Area Catholic Community and to instruct the faithful in the Catholic faith by way of his homilies and teaching. He is to reach out to those who are poor, suffering and dying and to serve non-Catholics and those who no longer practice the Catholic faith.

The pastor ensures that the sacraments, especially the Holy Eucharist and the Sacrament of Penance, are available to his people. He invites Catholics to read Sacred Scripture, study the Catechism of the Catholic Church, read Catholic spiritual books and develop a strong prayer life. The pastor is assisted by the Parochial Vicar, the Area Catholic Community Pastoral Council, the Parish Life Committees, other parish committees, the ACC Business Manager and the Parish Finance Councils.

A parochial vicar is assigned by the bishop to cooperate with the pastor in carrying out the pastoral ministry of the ACC. The term "parochial vicar" means that such a priest "represents" the pastor within the ACC. All of the above can be summarized by a short phrase: team ministry. Fr. Marv and I have agreed that teamwork will be the trademark of our ministry. You will be very pleased when you see how well we will work together. We ask you to pray for us as we serve the WOHVn in Faith Area Catholic Community.
