The Bible never said that.....

Mary Magdalene has been given a bad press since the sixth century because teachers and preachers have said that she was a prostitute. They have taught their audiences that she was the unnamed sinful woman who anointed the feet of Jesus. But the New Testament never equated that woman with Mary Magdalene. And in 2016 Pope Francis set the story straight. He declared that there is no evidence that we can equate the two and that Mary Magdalene is the Apostle to the Apostles.

What does "Apostle to the Apostles" mean? According to Saint Paul, an apostle is a person who sees the Risen Lord and then brings that Good News to others. Mary Magdalene was weeping outside the tomb when Jesus appeared to her and said, "Mary." She said, "Raubbouni! Teacher!" He instructed her to go to the apostles and tell them, "I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God." She was the first to see the Risen Lord and she ran to tell the other apostles. Thus, she was the Apostle to the Apostles.

Pope Francis also raised up the importance of her saint's day on the liturgical calendar. He elevated her celebration from a memorial day to a feast day. Her rank is now equal to that of the Twelve Apostles because each apostle has a feast day. Her feast day is on July 22.
