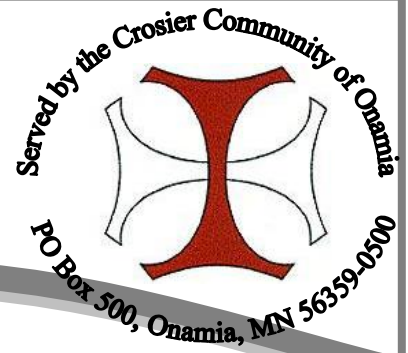

Missionary Weekend

This weekend the parish communities of St. Therese, Holy Cross and Sacred Heart will be invited to participate in the missionary work of the church. (St. Rita had its Missionary Weekend on April 13-14.). Two sisters from the Little Sisters of St. Francis Community will describe the work of their community in Uganda, Tanzania and the U.S. The Catholic definition of mission underwent a major change in the twentieth century. In previous centuries the church would travel with colonial powers and bring the Gospel to "new lands" as they were being colonized. In other words, the church became part of the colonizing movement of Western Europe. The beginning of the new thinking began with Pope Benedict XV in his 1919 encyclical Maximum Illud. He called the church to separate herself from colonialism and to respect the faith traditions of native people. Pope Pius XII and Pope John XXIII carried this concept forward by saying that all Christians are called to spread the Gospel. Please support the missions with your prayers and your financial support.
