The Crosier Confreres from the Democratic Republic of the Congo

You may have been asking, "Who are those Crosiers from the Congo that we see from time to time." Here's the answer: Father Zawadi, OSC, Father Moise, OSC and Brother Eric, OSC. Fr. Zawadi and Fr. Moise work in the Crosier Development Office and go around the nation and preach for the Crosier Missions. They are raising funds for the Crosier parishes and schools in Indonesia and the Congo. Their mission work in Indonesia serves the poorest of the poor on the island of New Guinea. Their mission work in the Congo serves the adults and children who have been traumatized by a bloody civil war that has lasted more than 25 years. Brother Eric, OSC is also with us and you may have seen him serving as an acolyte at the Sunday Masses. Brother Eric is a seminarian and he is taking classes in the School of Theology at Saint John's University in Colledgeville.

Pope Francis visited the Congo on February 1-2 of this year. His message included these words: "Tormented by war, the Democratic Republic of the Congo continues to suffer within its borders from conflicts and forced migrations and terrible forms of exploitation. And as you, Congolese, struggle to safeguard your dignity and territorial integrity against despicable attempts to fragment your country, I come to you, in the name of Jesus, as a pilgrim of reconciliation and peace. I have longed very much to be here and I come to bring you the closeness, affection and consolation of the whole Catholic Church."
