Crosier Fathers and Brothers Elect a New Superior

The Crosier Fathers and Brothers have elected Fr. Alex Juguilon, OSC, to serve as their new Conventual Prior for a four-year term. The election took place last week during their weeklong Conventual Priory Chapter in Onamia. The Rite of Installation took place on August 9 at the Holy Cross Priory Church in Onamia. Father Alex succeeds Father Tom Enneking, OSC, who served as the major superior for past 13 years.

Father Alex is from Cleveland, Ohio, and he learned about the Crosiers from Father Ernie Martello, OSC, who is also from Cleveland. He joined the Crosiers as a novice and made his first profession of vows on December 7, 2012, at the Crosier priory in Onamia. Father Alex was ordained to the priesthood on May 26, 2018, at Saint Gregory Catholic Church in Phoenix. His office is located in the Crosier priory in Phoenix.

Father Alex shared these reflections after he was elected: "To be asked to serve in this new leadership role is a privilege and I am grateful that my confreres have placed their trust in me. I am both honored and humbled to receive their call. The opportunity to share in their fraternal life, prayer and service to the church is the main reason I became a Crosier."
