All Saints Day

All Saints Day, the day on which Catholics celebrate all the saints, known and unknown, is a surprisingly old feast. It arose out of the Christian tradition of celebrating the martyrdom of saints on the anniversary of their martyrdom. When martyrdoms increased during the persecutions of the late Roman Empire, some local dioceses instituted a common feast day in order to ensure that all martyrs, known and unknown, were properly honored. Other dioceses created a common feast day for all of their martyrs because there were not enough feast days in a year for each martyr to have a personal feast day.

By the late fourth century, this common feast was celebrated in Antioch and Saint Ephrem the Syrian mentioned it in a sermon in 373. In the early centuries, this feast was celebrated during the Easter season and the Eastern Churches, both Catholic and Orthodox, still celebrate it then.

In the Western Church this celebration was originally confined to the diocese of Rome. During his papacy, Pope Gregory IV (827-844) extended the feast to the entire Church and ordered it to be celebrated on November 1. The purpose of this feast is to honor all those who excelled in their love for God. All Saints Day is a Holy Day of Obligation and our Mass schedule on November 1 is as follows:
