Rediscover the Teachings of the Second Vatican Council

In his recent speeches, Pope Leo has asked Catholics to pick up the documents of the Second Vatican Council and read them carefully. Look at what they actually say and stop listening to hearsay and unfounded statements. Has he actually been that challenging and blunt? Yes he has. He wants us to get back to the basics.

The Council convened for four sessions from 1962 to 1965 and produced 16 documents. It gave us teachings regarding Sacred Scripture, liturgy, missionary activity, ecumenism, interfaith relationships and religious freedom. The Council called for the active and conscious participation of the laity in each liturgy. It also challenged us to proclaim the Gospel joyfully and to be courageous witnesses to justice and peace. The Council said that the Church should define herself as the sacrament of unity between God and His people.

Pope Leo says that the teachings of the Second Vatican Council are “the guiding star” that the Catholic Church should follow in the midst of the struggles of our modern world.
