On this third Advent Sunday, we Christians gratefully acknowledge that life in God is good. This statement of faith challenges many people in today's world who have either sidelined God in life or outright erased the Divine.

The words of Isaiah give strong biblical testimony that God is engaged with us, especially in our difficult times. The desert blooms and humans stand tall despite their infirmities as they await the coming of the Lord "with joy and gladness".

To impatient believers, the Letter of St. James has a word of wisdom, "Be patient" like "the farmer who waits for the precious fruit of the earth." Stay faithful to Gospel living a little while longer, "because the coming of the Lord is at hand."

In today's Gospel, Jesus confirms to John the Baptist (and all other doubters) that he is the Messiah. He invites John to examine the evidence, the lives of suffering people that have been radically changed because of Jesus. We are reminded that John, despite his religious stature and the attention he gets, is not the Messiah, but the "precursor" sent ahead to prepare the way for Christ.

Questions to reflect on this Sunday: In my lowest and darkest moments, do I keep faith? And if not, to whom or what do I turn for rescue? What has been my success rate with them?
