A Catholic Marriage is a Covenant.

Many people don't know that marriage is a covenant. Most people in our country think that marriage is a contract. Almost every movie and almost every TV show and many websites describe marriage as a contract. But in the Catholic world marriage is a covenant - and that is very different!

For example, a contract is for a limited period of time while a covenant lasts forever. A contract engages only a part of a person while a covenant engages the whole person. When a baseball player signs a contract he does not give his whole life to his team - just his baseball skills. In the marriage covenant you give your total self to your spouse.

Children can enter into contracts but only mature adults can make a covenant. A contract is witnessed by the state while a covenant is witnessed by God. Within our Church we ask each other to think about marriage as a covenant. Just as the Bible says that Jesus has a covenant love for his people, so, we expect spouses to have a covenant love for each other.
