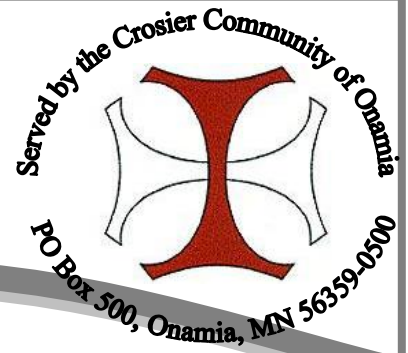

Some Reflections on the Topic of Grief

Dr. Jacqui Lewis has written: "Because we are human, we hurt when we suffer a loss. Because we are human, we have tears to cry. Because we are human, our hearts are broken. Because we are human, we understand that loss is a universal language.

Everybody grieves. All of humanity grieves. All of us have setbacks and broken dreams. All of us have broken relationships and unrealized possibilities. All of us have bodies that just don't do what they used to do. Many of us have experienced a job loss. Grief is personal and every person grieves."

Sister Joyce Rupp has written: "Although grief is painful it can have some positive side effects. (1) Grief connects us with others because everyone is grieving. It helps us to walk in the shoes of our neighbors. (2) Grief drives us to become more reflective. It causes us to look at the bigger picture and think about the meaning and purpose of life. (3) Grief drives us to our knees and causes us to be prayerful. It leads us to say the words that Jesus said during his time on the cross, 'Father, I place my life into your hands.' "

We share these reflections because we believe that we need to talk about grief more often. Sharing our thoughts and feelings about our personal grief does not eliminate the pain but it does reduce the pain.
