A Chronology of recent events regarding Indian boarding schools:

November, 2021 In a letter to all of the Catholic bishops of the United States the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' Committee on Domestic Justice and Human Development encouraged all bishops to make connections with tribal leaders to take steps to foster healing.

December 9, 2021 The tribal leaders from the state of Minnesota and the Catholic bishops of Minnesota met to discuss how the tribes and the church can work together to help heal the trauma caused by involuntarily removing children from their homes, sending them to distant boarding schools and condemning their language, culture and traditions. Archbishop Bernard Hebda said, "There are women and men in our archdiocese and across our state who have personally experienced the boarding school system. They are with us now. Their stories must be told and we must listen to them. We must also listen to the voices of the children and grandchildren whose ancestors endured such pain."

April 1, 2022 While meeting with Canada's Indigenous delegation in Rome Pope Francis apologized for the church's role in the Canadian Indian boarding schools. Pope Francis asked for forgiveness "for the role that a number of Catholics ... had in all these things that wounded you, in the abuses you suffered and in the lack of respect shown for your identity, your culture and your spiritual values."

May 11, 2022 The Department of the Interior issued its report.

May 12, 2022 "As a bishop in Minnesota, I read with sadness the Federal Indian Boarding School Initiative report released yesterday by the U.S. Department of the Interior," Archbishop Hebda said in a statement posted on the archdiocese's website. "It is an important first step in what I anticipate will be a painful but necessary journey for our country and for our church," the archbishop said.

May 15, 2022 1. We are hopeful that Pope Francis will apologize for the church's role in the boarding schools in the United States. 2. I serve as the liaison for Indian affairs for the diocese of Saint Cloud. 3. I have attended several workshops concerning the intergenerational trauma caused by the Indian boarding schools and I would love to share what I have learned with individuals and/or groups.
