## Encore: A New Stage in Our Lives

The dictionary defines “encore” as an additional performance attached to the end of a concert. Researchers are now using “encore” to refer to the time period that comes after leaving the workforce. This time period is not retirement time but encore time. It is the time when people make some of their most important contributions for society and for the well-being of future generations.
