### "It is the Lord!"

Jesus made multiple appearances to his disciples after his resurrection. The reason should be obvious. His death and resurrection were God's final investment in renewing the initial creation marred by Adam's Fall. In Christ, God opened out the new future for humanity in a recreated world. The appearances of Jesus after his resurrection are testimony to God's determination to see it through.

The New Testament witnesses to this world-changing event met with constant interference, as we hear from the *Acts of the Apostles* today. But the conviction that Jesus was indeed their "leader and savior," exalted at God's right hand, was fortified again and again by his appearances to them. Suffering for speaking the truth about this was a badge of honor for them. In Jesus Risen, God finally accomplished all their ancestors and humanity hoped for.

The heavens also bore witness to God's act of redemption in Christ. The community of disciples was privileged to hear "the voices of many angels who surrounded the throne and the living creatures and elders," shouting acclamations to "the Lamb." We read this in the *Book of Revelation* today. With all of this ringing in their ears, the disciples knew that God's great accomplishment was real and powerful, now and forever.

In the Gospel today, Jesus Risen "revealed himself" once again among his disciples fishing. The great catch of 150 fish, followed by a seashore breakfast with Jesus, assured them once more: "It is the Lord!" Peter, feeling the sting of his triple denial of the Lord and coached now to make his triple confession of love for Jesus, received his sacred assignment: "Feed my sheep." Peter was to head up nourishing the Church with the Gospel, the Good News of Jesus' death and resurrection.

On this occasion, Jesus gave his fishing disciples their vocations. Whatever turn of events they might encounter, blessed or painful, they would follow his lead, bringing all of humanity into the New Creation, won by Jesus' Death and Resurrection. They would remain strong and confident in the one who kept appearing to them.

That is what our post-Easter liturgies mean to do for us.
