Synod 2021 – 2023

Living in the Easter Season, our attention as Catholics is to grow in the New Life that has been given to us from the passion, death & resurrection of Jesus. Growing in the Lord happens in many ways. We have a unique chance to grow closer in our WOHVn-in-Faith community and to the Lord by participating in the Synod 2021 – 2023. The Holy Father, Pope Francis, opened Synod 2021 – 2023 in October last year. The goal of the Synod is to open the hearts of Catholics to be **present to one another, learn from each other & grow in the Love of the Lord**. The Diocese of St. Cloud has set a goal of listening to 12,000 individuals from within the diocese. You ask, “How can I participate?” Here are several ways for all of us to be a part of the Synod.

One way is to become a “Listener” for our Area Catholic Community (ACC) and diocese. The diocese offers training for people who would like to lead listening groups. The Listener could then plan listening sessions here at our WOHVn-in-Faith parishes. The Diocese has asked each ACC to host at least one listening session. Stay tune for a Listening Session to happen in our ACC WOHVn-In-Faith community.

Listening groups are happening already. They are scheduled to take place all-across the diocese. So, here is another alternative, you could visit another parish that has a listening session scheduled. (Please; visit the diocese’s website www.stcdio.org for the growing list of listening sessions.)

Okay, so you say, “I do not want to lead a group”, and groups are too big for me, another way to participate is to schedule a 1 to 1 listening meeting with a Listener. You can email your request to synod@gw.stcdio.org And a Listener from the diocese will contact you to schedule a listening time.

So, the 1 to 1 may seem too personal & you’re not ready to travel to another parish, however you can go online to share your thoughts with Jesus and the diocese from your computer. You can go inline to fill out the survey by visiting: <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/HGRMJ6X> for the self-guided consultation.

So, here are five ways to participate. Please take the time to share your thoughts with the diocese. Think about how you impact the parish, our WOHVn-in-Faith community and the diocese as you demonstrate / give witness to your Love of the Lord.
