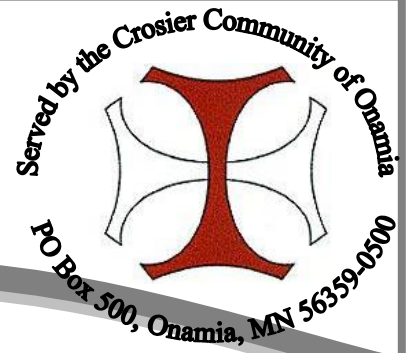

August 28: The Feast of Saint Augustine

Each year the church calendar says that August 28 is the Feast of Saint Augustine. He was a superb philosopher and he has often been labeled as being the first psychologist. Many paintings and statues show him wearing bishop's vestments and holding a heart in his hand, Why? Because his writings focus on the warmth and love that flow from the heart. He said, "We come to God through loving one another." He believed that human love has God's love running through it.

His teachings about prayer flow out of that conviction. Augustine challenges us to pray with our hearts intent on knowing God and seeing God in our neighbor. His Confessions begin with these words: "You made us for yourself, O God, and have directed us toward yourself. Our hearts are restless until we rest in you." The Saint Augustine Night Prayer reveals his compassionate spirit and it is found in many Catholic prayer books. "Dear Lord, watch over those who wake or watch or weep tonight. Give your angels charge over those who sleep. Tend your sick ones, O Lord Jesus Christ, give rest to your weary ones, bless your dying ones, soothe your suffering ones, shield your joyous ones and do all for your love's sake. Amen."

Saint Augustine also wrote a Rule of Life and it is followed by the Crosier Order and many other religious orders.
