Saints Peter and Paul

Normally, today would be the Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. Why, then, are we celebrating the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul?

Solemnities are the highest level of liturgical celebration. There are fourteen of them on the universal Catholic calendar, some of which replace the ordinary Sunday when their dates fall on a Sunday. The Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul is one of them.

Martyr Peter, the first Pope, and martyr Paul, the preacher to the Gentiles, are the two most important leaders in the establishment and growth of the early Church. They witnessed their commitment by the shedding of their blood.

The reading from *Acts* speaks about Peter. He lives his Christian life always under a cloud of imprisonment and death. But the hand of the Lord is always on him because he was chosen to be the rock of the new Christian community. Today we find him chained in prison. He is stunned as an angel releases him, leading him through police posts and out the front gates into the city. He will continue evangelizing until his tragic death sometime later.

The Gospel reading shows Peter's total engagement with Christ, as he declares, "*You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.*" With this, Peter receives his call to rock-like leadership of the Church.

In the *Second Letter to Timothy*, Paul speaks about emptying out his life for Christ. He maintains the great hope that he will be rewarded, along with all the disciples, at the soon return of Jesus. Until that moment, Paul stays zealous for the Gentiles, facing the "lion's mouth" and all kinds of suffering because he proclaims Christ's Gospel.

To learn all about Christ is one thing, but to face the challenges of living out what one knows is another. Saints Peter and Paul are not only teachers to the whole Church. They are also mentors for how to suffer through, with courage and hope, the sometimes-overwhelming trials of a life of Christian faith. Today the Church expresses her gratitude to them and lets herself be emboldened anew by their stories for living faithfully as Christians in our own day.
