Prayer for Christian Unity

January 18-25 marks the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. This annual observance is sponsored jointly by the Protestant World Council of Churches and the Catholic Pontifical Council for Christian Unity. This annual observance began in 1968 and it invites all Christians everywhere to remember one another in prayer and to strengthen the bonds of love and the mutual mission that we share in Christ.

While the observance is commonly referred to as a Week of Prayer it lasts for eight full days. The number eight is important in the Christian understanding of salvation history. The resurrection of Jesus on Easter Sunday marks that day as the "eighth day of creation." Easter Sunday is the day when Jesus received new life and all things were created anew in Him. (2 Corinthians 5:17) Many baptismal pools and fonts have eight sides because in baptism we are buried with Christ in his death and raised with him to walk in newness of life (Romans 6:4). The eight days of prayer across all of our churches reflects our confidence that our Risen Lord will make us one.

The theme of the observance for 2023 is "Do good; seek justice" (Isaiah 1:17). Those words invite us to say the following **Church Unity Prayer** in our homes at meal time this week.

Gracious and loving God, Help us to expand our vision so that we might see the mission that we share with all of our Christian sisters and brothers. Yes, Lord, you call all Christians to put into practice the justice and loving kindness of your kingdom. Help us to do justice, to show kindness and to walk humbly with you.

We ask this through Christ, our Lord. Amen.
